This Privacy Policy describes how the Doggy app handles your information. We value your privacy and are committed to protecting it.

1. No Personal Data Collection

Doggy does not collect, store, or share any personal information from its users. We do not require you to create an account or provide any identifying details to use the app.

2. Photo Processing

When you scan a dog using the app, the photo is temporarily sent to an image analysis service to identify the dog breed. Specifically:

- Photos are not saved locally or in the cloud.
- Photos are not collected or stored by the Doggy app or its developers.
- Images are sent securely to OpenAI for analysis and deleted immediately after processing.

3. Use of OpenAI Services

We use OpenAI's image analysis API to process photos for dog breed recognition. By using Doggy, you acknowledge that your images are sent to OpenAI solely for this purpose.
